Windermere and Ambleside Lions Club is part of Lions Clubs International, the largest service organisation in the world with 1.4 million members.

Lions Clubs International was founded in 1917 in America by Melvin Jones and now consists of over 46,000 clubs in 208 countries. The first Lions club in the UK was formed in London on March 1st 1950 encouraged by some Canadian Lions who had helped British children during the war.


On a visit to Canada, Queen Elizabeth, the Queen Mother, had personally thanked these Lions for their help and they suggested that a Lions Club should be formed in England. Lions in the British

Isles and Ireland now make up 945 clubs with a total of over 20,000 members.

The Lions Club of Windermere and Ambleside currently has 17 members and serves the communities of Windermere and Ambleside and also Grasmere, Hawkshead and Staveley helping financially with youth projects, organising entertainment and trips for the elderly and disabled, delivering firewood in the winter to those who need it and lending a hand at local community events. The club raises money with events such as this classic vehicle show; with the summer fun festival and with the bouncy castle in Bowness on summer weekends.

Through the Lions Clubs International Foundation the club also helps with projects overseas including relief in disaster areas and provision of clean water, work to eradicate preventable blindness and other medical help for developing countries.




